- 1. Class 3 Provisional:
  - Minimum 1st Dan
  - Participants will be awarded Class 3 (Provisional) upon successful completion of the National Kyorugi Referee Course conducted by the Singapore Taekwondo Federation (STF)

### 2. Class 3:

- Holding Class 3 (Provisional) National Kyorugi Referee qualification
- Officiated in minimally two (2) tournaments of which
  - One (1) must be National Competition or National School Games
- Minimum of 30 hours of officiating experiences accumulated
- Valid Kyorugi Referee License
  - Attended the Referees' refresher seminar for the current year
- Approved by the Board of Referees

#### 3. Class 2:

- Minimum 2nd Dan
- Holding Class 3 National Kyorugi Referee qualification for at least one (1) year
- Officiated in minimally four (4) tournaments of which
  - Two (2) must be National Competitions or National School Games
- Minimum of 40 hours of officiating experiences accumulated in the capacity as a Class 3 Referee
- Valid Kyorugi Referee License
  - Attended the Referees' refresher seminar for the current year
- Approved by the Board of Referees

### 4. Class 1:

- Minimum 3rd Dan
- Holding Class 2 National Kyorugi Referee qualification for at least two (2) years
- Officiated in minimally eight (8) tournaments of which
  - Three (3) must be National Competitions or National School Games
- Minimum of 60 hours of officiating experiences accumulated in the capacity as a Class 2 Referee
- Valid Kyorugi Referee License
  - o Attended the Referees' refresher seminar for the current year
- Approved by the Board of Referees

- 5. Class "S":
  - Minimum 4th Dan
  - Holding Class 1 National Kyorugi Referee qualification for at least three (3) years
  - Officiated in minimally twelve (12) tournaments of which
    - Four (4) must be National Competition or National School Games
  - Minimum of 90 hours of officiating experiences accumulated in the capacity as a Class 1 Referee
  - Valid Kyorugi Referee License
    - o Attended the Referees' refresher seminar for the current year
  - Approved by the Board of Referees
- 6. Class "1" referees who intend to be apply for promotion to Class "S" are required to be assessed by Board of Referees (or equivalent) appointed by the Referee Sub Committee's Chairman.
- 7. On meeting the minimum requirements, a national referee may submit his / her application for promotion to the Board of Referees for consideration on the prescribed form, available at the STF's office.
- 8. International Referee (IR):

Any Class "S" National Referee who has fulfilled the following requirements will be considered for the International Referee (IR) Course organised by the World Taekwondo (WT):

- Minimum Kukkiwon 4th Dan Holder
- Performed at least 1 x Chief Referee (CR) for any STF competition
- Recommended by the Board of Referees
- Approved by the Technical Standing Committee

As there might be special considerations/waivers allowed by WT for the IR courses from time to time, the Technical Standing Committee reserves the Rights to waive certain requirements if applicable.

Upon STF's Technical Standing Committee endorsement of the IR application, the Class "S" National Referee will have to apply and successfully complete the WT Online Referee Training Programme.

### Notes:

1. The STF's Board of Referees reserves the right to select and recommend suitable National Referee candidate(s) to STF's Technical Standing Committee for the IR course.

- 2. The STF's Board of Referees reserves the right to give priority to candidates who meet both the World Taekwondo IR course requirement and requirements stated in item 7.
- 3. The STF's Technical Standing Committee reserves the right to approve National Referee candidate(s) recommendation based on the following:
  - o Number of vacancies available for the IR course
  - o Candidate's seniority in Taekwondo
- 4. Referees who have not been actively refereeing for the past one (1) year will need to clock in additional half of the hours on top of the required hours for whichever class they are applying for. I.e. Referees should be actively refereeing for X number of years if they are targeting to promote with minimum required hours of the new class.
