7. METHOD OF COMPETITION

- i. Cut-Off system Direct Finals (Top 8 medallists)
- ii. Duration of Contest Up to 90 seconds
- iii. Number of courts: 4
- iv. Competition Flow: The sequence of performance* for competitors shall be
 - Recognized Individual
 Recognized Pair / Team / Siblings / Family
 Para Taekwondo

*Computer generated sequencing for all categories

v. Number of participant: No limit to number of participants fielded for all events**

**Individual events: Participant may participate in only one individual colour category of their belt category.

Colour Belt and Poom Belt (Same Grade) Team events: Shall comprise of three (3) participants holding the same grade. Each participant is allowed to participate in one poomsae team event of their own belt category.

Poom Belt Team events (Mixed Grades): May comprise of three (3) participants holding different Poom Grades. Team will compete in the belt event of the highest Poom belter within the team (i.e. Team comprises of a Poom 1, Poom 2 & Poom 3, Team will compete in the 3rd Poom event).

8. **REGISTRATION**

i. Registration shall be done by the Team Manager, who can be a coach, or someone designated to take charge of the Team.

ii. Team Managers **must** register through the Tournament Management System (TMS) at below link

iii. The closing date for submission is on 4th August 2025, this includes

- **Committing Team Registration** (Tick and confirm registration on homepage)
- Uploading proof of payment (STF Paynow UEN: S74SS0031A)
- Uploading of all participants' grade proof on TMS platform

iv. Submission **will not be processed** if any information submitted is incorrect / incomplete.



v. Team Managers are to ensure that individual participant registration forms are available for verification by organiser when required.

vi. The organiser reserves the rights to disqualify the club submission if the team manager fails to make payment or verify participants grades by 4th August 2025.

vii. Competition Schedule and Bout will be released by 13th August 2025.

Step-by-Step e-registration process

- 1. Registration of team on following registration e-guide
- 2. Ensure committing team registration on registration home page
- 3. Ensure members complete their indemnity form before closing date 4th August 2025

It is the responsibility of the Team Managers to verify and ensure that the submission is accurate, and information of the participants are valid. Wrong submission will result in disqualification of registration.

Registration of participants in a different grade from grading document can result in up to 1-year debarment of team participation from STF organized competitions and relevant parties called up for sanction, such incidents would be regarded as a breach of integrity.

9. EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORM

- i. Only STF approved uniforms should be worn, participants who wears unapproved uniform will not be permitted to compete. The latest STF approved uniform list can be viewed at www.stf.sg under Guidelines.
- ii. Taping (if any) must be inspected and signed by STF on-site medical team before competing.



10. COACH REQUIREMENTS

i. Only Poomsae level 2 coaches wearing coach pass will be allowed to enter the Field of Play (FOP) and coach their participants.

ii. Team Manager and Poomsae level 1 coaches (wearing coach pass) are not allowed to enter the FOP with participants.

iii. Non-qualified coaches or coaches holding the wrong coach pass entering the FOP will result in immediate disqualification with follow-up disciplinary action taken against the affected coach and team, following the STF Rules and Regulations.

iv. All coaches must attire in either track pants or business pants, collared shirt, or jackets/windbreakers and 70% white-covered shoes.

v. Teams must provide sufficient coaches to accompany participants into the FOP when their bouts are called to ensure flow of the competition. Insufficient coaches causing a delay in competition flow may result in disqualification of affected participant.

vi. Participant entering the FOP without their coach will result in disqualification of affected participant.

11. REFEREES & VOLUNTEERS REQUIREMENTS

i. Volunteer: Each team must provide 1 volunteer per competition day *(minimum 15 years old).*

ii. Referees: Each team must provide 1 referee for every 50 registration or part-thereof.

iii. Each team must provide required number of volunteer and referee(s) throughout all days of competition.

I.e. Team A has registered 100 Individual Poomsae Event and 1 Team Poomsae Event, Team A must provide 1 volunteer and 3 referees for ALL competitions days. Team B has registered 99 individual event and 1 Team Poomsae event, Team B must provided 1 volunteer and 2 referees for ALL competition days. Event Submissions with more than 1 participant (Team/Pair/Siblings/Family) will be regarded as 1 registration.

iv. Required number of referees **might** reduce dependent on sign-up rates, finalized referees required for each team will be announced during Team Manager briefing.However, teams must prepare sufficient referees based upon point ii and iii.

v. Teams that do not fulfil Volunteer <u>OR</u> Referee requirement on any competition day may be barred from STF organized competition for a period of 1 year (from debarment date)



12. AWARD & CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

i. The following prizes will be awarded

1 st Placing:	1 Gold Medal
2 nd Placing:	1 Silver Medal
3 rd ~ 8 th Placing:	6 Bronze Medal

ii. All medallists must be attired in full uniform during prize presentation.

iii. Default medallist (participants with no opponent) need not perform their pattern and can be awarded the gold medal by reporting to the registration counter on their competing event day.

13. DRAWING OF LOT

i. Competition bout list will be finalized via Tournament Management System random draw,

Organizing Committee reserves the right to separate and re-allocate competing categories dependent on registration numbers (e.g Splitting family event further into Father and Son/ Mother and Son)

ii. Team Managers may write in to Organizing Committee at <u>Tournament.stf@gmail.com</u> for competition related matters.

iii. All form of communication from Organizing Committee will be directed only to Team Manager's email **<u>stated in the registration portal.</u>**

iv. Competition schedule and bout list will be released by 13th August, <u>strictly no</u> <u>request for amendment</u> will be allowed afterwards.

14. ARBITRATION & PROTEST MATTERS

i. Protest with regards to competition matters and results must be made by registered Team Manager or Coach on competition day within 10 minutes of pertinent bout.

ii. Any protest made against a judgment shall be made on the arbitration form and submitted together with the fee of \$327.00 (GST inclusive) to the Competition Supervisory Board within 10 minutes of the pertinent contest.

iii. Arbitration form may be found in Annex B – Forms.



15. DECLARATION & INDEMNITIES

i. Any previous training in other martial arts must be declared on registration form. (e.g. types of martial art; level and years of training)

ii. Team Manager must ensure that all participants (parents of participants under 21 years old) personally endorse the indemnity forms. Team Manager will be held responsible if the forms contain fake signatures.

iii. Team Manager / Coach(es) to ensure that their participants are prepared and fit for the competition. Team Manager / Coach (es) should withdraw any participant who is not feeling well on the day of the competition.

iv. Team Manager must declare pre-existing medical conditions on electronic registration form under remarks column and attach document of doctor's clearance letter for medical conditions declared.

iv. Team Manager must ensure all team members* shall have their own medical insurance coverage, including first aid and personal accident insurance.

*Team members refer to all member that identifies with the Team, including but not limited to Team Manager, Coaches, Participants, Volunteers, Referees and Supporters.



Annex A – PARA TAEKWONDO

Para Taekwondo Sport Classes

- P10 Visual Impairments (blind and visually impaired)
- P20 Intellectual Impairments (mentally challenged individuals including Autism)

P30 – Neurological Impairments (neurological condition caused by damage to the brain includes Hypertonia/Spasticity, Athetosis & Dystonia and Ataxia)

P40 – Physical Impairments (limitation affecting movement and strength due to neuromuscular conditions, joint stiffness or deformities like ankyloses or contractures, limb loss or malformation (dysmelia) and leg length differences caused by growth disturbances or trauma)

P50 – Assistive Technology (lower limb or truncal impairments that affect their ability to stand and would need an assistive device to support movement)

P60 – Hearing Impairments

- Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55dB in the better ear (3 tone frequency average of 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, ANSI 1969 standard)
- No using hearing aids or external cochlear implant aids during competition event
