The Singapore Taekwondo Federation (STF) 48th Annual General Meeting (AGM) proceeded at 2.00pm on 27 September 2025 with Mr. Wong Zhen Kang, Secretary General of STF, reporting a quorum of 33 Full Members out of 81 Full members and another 2 Associate Members out of 61 Associate Members present at the meeting. The minimum number of Full members required to form a quorum is 21 Full members, which was met.

1 WELCOME MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT OF SINGAPORE TAEKWONDO FEDERATION, PROFESSOR TAN CHENG HAN

1.1 Prof. Tan Cheng Han thanked and welcomed all affiliates to the Singapore Taekwondo Federation (STF) 48th Annual General Meeting (AGM). He mentioned that it was customary for the President to provide a Welcome Address. The full version of the Welcome Address was in the Annual Report and he would like to highlight a few key points.

1.1.1 The past year has been one of significant activity and purpose. STF had numerous designed to benefit the affiliates and wider Taekwondo community. STF's calendar was packed with events and activities which included Quarterly Centralized Gradings, and a variety of educational and certification courses for referees and coaches, Coach Induction, etc. STF also saw great participation in numerous tournaments that served as platforms for Taekwondo athletes to compete at a high level against their peers, foster

community, camaraderie and sportsmanship, e.g. National School Games, Get Active Pesta Sukan Taekwondo Championships and Singapore Open Championships 2025. STF is also committed to ensure that Taekwondo is an inclusive sport for all members of our community, we organized the Singapore National Para Poomsae Championships and Para Taekwondo was also incorporated into the Active SG Pesta Sukan Taekwondo Championships. On the International level, last year was also very important as we did well in the Olympic e-sports games when Virtual Taekwondo was included for the first time as an international competitive sport. STF also successfully organized the inaugural World Taekwondo Virtual Taekwondo Championships. This is another area which STF wants to continually develop to win glory for Singapore because the government will then provide greater funding support which will be crucial for the continued development of our sport. STF hopes that we can continue to do well at the international level in the years leading up to the 2029 SEA Games which Singapore is hosting.

1.1. 2 STF also did reasonably well for High Performance level, e.g. WT President's Cup (Oceania) in Australia we won 6 gold medals and at the 6th Asian Taekwondo Open we won 2 gold, 2 silver and 4 bronze medals. STF athletes also made a strong debut at the 2024 World Virtual Taekwondo Championships; winning a total of 4 gold, 4 silver and 1 bronze medals. This was only possible due to the concerted effort of the entire community in building the pipeline of athletes for the sport and for which STF is very thankful for.

1.1. 3 Last year, the STF office and the National Kyorugi team moved its training centre to 7 Bedok North. This was part of the SportSG initiative to include STF/Taekwondo as part of the Singapore Combat Sports Centre (SCSC) where various combat sports are grouped within a centralized training facility to reap the synergistic benefits from training together. Amongst the combat sports we are the lead institution to manage the other tenants of the SCSC which is testimony of the trust they have in STF. For this role, STF has also been provided additional support, e.g. the funds which STF would have had to bear for the CEO's salary would now be funded and the savings on this expenditure could now be used for high performance and other programmes.

1.1. 4 As of the last AGM in 2024, six Board Members stepped down as they had reached their term limit, i.e. Mr. David Koh, Mr. Sebastian Lee, Mr. Lai Han Seng, Mr. Johnny Lim, Mr. Andy Lee Thiam Poh and Mr. Alvin Tan Cheng Hui. Their contributions have been monumental, and their unwavering dedication and commitment were instrumental to the development of Taekwondo in Singapore. In the same STF AGM 2024, we also welcomed six new Board Members, i.e. Mr. Darran Lee, Mr. Tok Yee Long, Mr. Ng Hwa Ann, Mr. Tan Gee Kee, Mr. Alan Lee and Mr. Daniel Kim. The new STF Board brought with them new perspectives and new energy and will continue to actively engage with STF's stakeholders and provide steady and bold stewardship to meet the challenges of the future.

Prof. Tan Cheng Han expressed his great appreciation to all volunteers within the various committees and sub-committees who have continued to selflessly

contribute their time and effort for STF. These acts of generosity and selflessness continue to cement STF's accomplishments, which are built on the solid foundation laid by our pioneers, including our late President, Mr. Milan Kwee, and our former General Manager, Mr. Lim Tiong Chin. The unwavering commitment and visionary leadership of our pioneers have been instrumental in paving the way for the growth and development of Taekwondo in Singapore.
